Enrichment Activity/Project: I

Touch and Learn: Creating a Braille Script Model

Competency: Sensory Understanding | Hands-on Craft Skills | Pattern Recognition

Activity:

Take a chart paper.

- Draw a grid on the paper using a scale: Each Braille letter is made up of a 2-column and 3-row grid (like a small rectangle of 6 spots).
- Write the English letters (A–Z) neatly on one side or top.

 Refer to a Braille alphabet chart (I'll share a basic one below!) and place the bindis where the raised dots should be for each alphabet.

- Stick bindis carefully in the 6-dot grid pattern to form each Braille letter.
- Label each Braille cell with its corresponding English letter for clarity.
- Decorate the edges lightly if you want to make it look colorful and neat!
 Learning Outcome:
- Students will demonstrate understanding of Braille script formation.
- Students will be able to describe the importance of Braille for visually impaired people.
- Students will develop fine motor skills and patience in sticking small objects accurately.


Enrichment Activity/Project: II

Activity:

- Create a Balanced Diet Chart on chart paper.
- Draw a colorful food pyramid like the one shown.
- Label the different food groups clearly:
 - a. Carbohydrates
 - b. Vitamins & Minerals
 - c. Proteins
 - d. Dairy Products
 - e. Fats & Sugars
- Draw or paste pictures of food items under each group (e.g., rice for carbohydrates, milk for dairy).
- Mention examples next to each picture.
- Write a short paragraph (4-5 lines) explaining: (EVS Copy)

- a. What is a balanced diet?
- b. Why is it important for our health?
- Decorate your chart neatly using borders and headings.
- You can also write a Healthy Eating Slogan like "Eat Well, Live Well!" or "Healthy Food, Healthy Mood!"
